We're looking for artists working in any medium, including:

- Painting
- Drawing
- Printmaking
- Photography
- Ceramics
- Sculpture
- Textiles
- Mixed media
- Illustration
- Installation
- Any other visual art form

Nature-inspired work is particularly welcome, reflecting the Greenhouses and gardens, but this is interpreted very broadly. If your work connects with the natural world in any way—or if you're simply excited to be part of the event—we'd love to hear from you.

There is **no fee to exhibit**, and artists keep 100% of any sales made during the evening.

Exhibition Spaces

We'd love to see artwork displayed throughout the Greenhouses and gardens, making the most of this unique setting.

The exhibition will take place across a variety of indoor and outdoor spaces, including:

- The Greenhouse
- The Barn
- The Gardens

We understand that every artwork has different display requirements, and we'd like to help you find the most suitable location for your work.

To keep the administration as simple as possible in the lead-up to the event, we'd appreciate it if you could complete [this short form](#), telling us a little about yourself, your artwork and any display requirements you may have.

Display Equipment

The Greenhouses will provide exhibition equipment wherever possible, including:

- Tables and chairs
- Hanging wires for ceiling or wall-mounted work
- A limited number of easels and tabletop easels

If you're able to bring your own frames, easels, plinths, display stands or any other specialist display equipment, it would be greatly appreciated.

Set-up & Take-down

Artists are asked to install and remove their work independently during the allocated set-up and take-down times.

Set-up will start from 2 hours before the event, with take-down taking place immediately after the event has finished.

Live Performances

Alongside the exhibition, we're looking for creative performances that complement the atmosphere of the evening.

This could include:

- Poetry
- Spoken word
- Puppetry
- Acoustic performance

- Storytelling
- Small-scale theatre
- Dance
- Other creative interventions

We are looking forward to hearing your ideas and proposals and discussing how this could work well for you and the event.

Music

We're also looking for **a musician or band** to perform during the evening. This performance will be **paid a small fee by Brockwell Park Community Greenhouses**.

Creative Drop-in Mini Workshops

Short, informal activities that visitors can join throughout the evening.

Examples might include:

- Ten-minute screen printing
- Botanical drawing
- Badge making
- Simple lino printing
- Nature journalling
- Creative collage
- Anything hands-on and accessible

Payment arrangements for these activities are currently being developed.

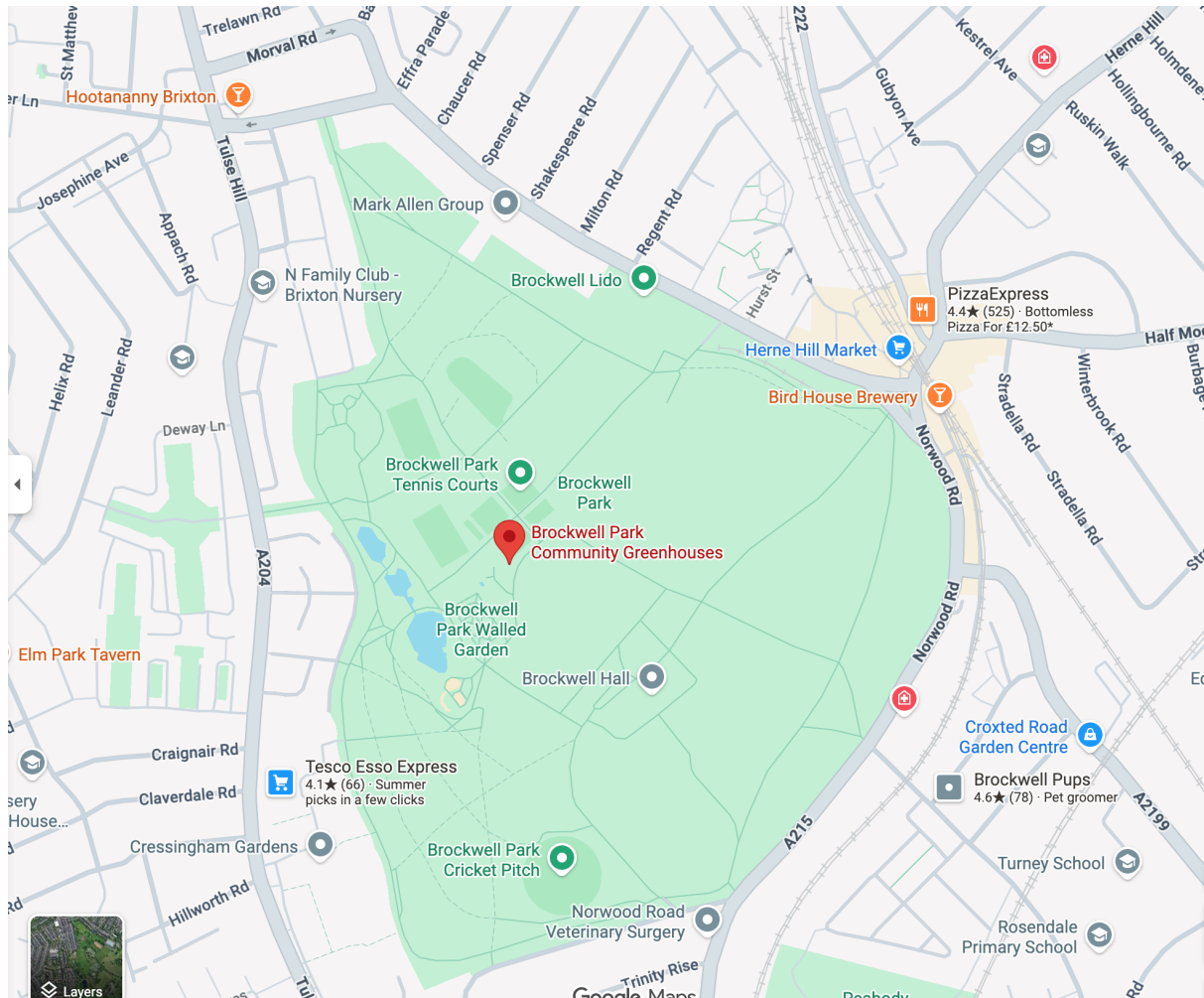
